When developing a defense strategy, the defense attorney considers the credibility of defense and prosecution witnesses, community attitudes toward the crime and the defendant, and the nature of the prosecution's evidence. An important ethical rule is that a defense attorney can't knowingly encourage or help a defendant lie under oath (in other words, commit perjury) and consequently is forbidden to call a witness who he or she knows will lie on the witness stand.
