The Boeing 737 Classic are narrow-body airliners produced by Boeing Commercial Airplanes, the second generation of the original Boeing 737-100/-200. Development began in 1979 and the first variant, the 737-300, first flew in February 1984 and entered service in December of that year. The stretched 737-400 first flew in February 1988 and entered service later that year The shortest variant, the 737-500, first flew in June 1989 and entered service in 1990. It is re-engined with higher bypass ratio

The 737-500 (originally known as the 737 Lite and the 737-1000) combined the original length fuselage of the -200, with the various improvements of the -300 and -400. Overall length 31.0m (101ft 9in), MTOW up to 60,555kg (133,500lb). The 737-500SP is a winglet equipped retrofit. This became available in 2007.

The Boeing 737 Classic is the name given to the -300/400/500 series after the introduction of the -600/700/800/900 series of the Boeing 737 family. Produced from 1984 to 2000, a total of 1,988 Classic series were delivered. The main development was to re-engine with the high pressure ratio CFM56-7.

They are short to medium range, narrow-body jet airliners produced by Boeing Commercial Airplanes. The Classic series was introduced as the 'new generation' of the 737.

The 737-300 was the middle-sized option, with a typical two-class capacity of 126 (an increase of 24 over the previous generation 737-200). The 737-400 continued this expansion. Stretching the 737-300 around three meters increased the capacity to 188. The range was slightly reduced to 3,820 kilometers (compared to 4,176 kilometers with the -300). And the 737-500 was offered as a smaller model.

The 737-500 is the shortest and smallest member of the second generation 737-300/-400/-500 family, and the last to be developed. When the new stretched 737-300 first appeared it was intended to supplement, rather than replace, the 737-200. However the evolution of the 737-300 into a family of models led to the development of a new model comparable in size to the 737-200, but offering better fuel economy and extensive commonality with the 737-300 and -400 models.
