When a Communicable Disease is Suspected • Separate the ill child from well children at the facility until the ill child can be taken home. • Inform parents immediately so that medical advice can be sought. • Adhere to the exclusion and readmission requirements provided on this chart.

Communicable Disease Notes. Nuisance Diseases. So-called “ nuisance ” diseases, such as scabies, head lice (pediculosis), ringworm of the body or scalp, and pinworms are highly contagious and can cause problems in a group-care setting. Children and adults with these conditions (except ringworm of the body and pinworms) should be excluded until treated.

- Zika is generally a mild illness but is associated with birth defects and possibly Guillain-Barré Syndrome
- Local transmission is possible in Texas
- Reducing mosquito breeding habitats reduces risk of many arboviruses including West Nile and Zika
