Advantages of Telephone surveys. -centralized control of data collection. -more cost-effective than personal interviews. -data collected quickly. Disadvantages of Telephone surveys. -resistance in collecting income, financial data. -limited depth of response. -disproportionate coverage of low-income segments. -abuse of phone by solicitors.
