Securing Urban Heritage considers the impact of securitization on access to urban heritage sites. Demonstrating that symbolic spaces such as these have increasingly become the location of choice for the practice and performance of contemporary politics in the last decade, the book shows how this has led to the securitization of urban public space. Highlighting specific changes that have been made, such as the installation of closed-circuit television or the limitation of access to certain streets, plazas and buildings, the book analyses the impact of different approaches to securitization. Claiming that access to heritage sites is a precursor to an informed and thorough understanding of heritage, the editors and contributors to this volume argue that new forms of securing urban heritage, including community involvement and digitalization, offer possibilities for the protection and use of urban heritage. Looking more closely at the versatile relationship between access and securitization in this context, the book provides a theoretical framework for the relationship between urban heritage and securitization. Comparing case studies from cities in Angola, Bulgaria, Eritrea, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Mexico, Norway, Russia, Suriname, Sweden, Turkey, UK, and the US, the book reveals some of the key mechanisms that are used to regulate access to heritage sites around the world. Providing much-needed insight into the diverse challenges of securitization for access and urban heritage, Securing Urban Heritage should be essential reading for academics, students, and practitioners from the fields of heritage and urban studies, architecture, art history, conservation, urban planning, and urban geography.

This book is about appreciation; it is an attempt to explain what architecture essentially is, rather than merely what it looks like. Architecture an Inspiration is addressed to those who enjoy buildings, cities and landscapes, and would like to have a deeper appreciation and a basis for their likes and dislikes. A full appreciation demands careful observation, and in these pages there are many explorations of this sort. The book is divided into two parts: the first is about the nature of architecture, describing what is necessary. The chapter headings define the basic requirements that, to varying degrees, must always be met, such as facilitating activity, moderating climate, relating to context, respecting materials and structure, as well as conveying meaning and delight. The second part is about the nature of designing and focuses on what the designer brings to the task to arrive at a human and poetic synthesis. These different ways of thinking are elusive and not necessarily conscious; they include the use of reason and intuition, the value of experience and precedent, the role of metaphor and the search for harmony. For students this is difficult, because there is no "right" way of designing. So much of what is written about the architecture of today is negative that it seemed opportune to take a positive approach and point to work that is good "now and in the past" and reiterate some timeless qualities. Architecture an Inspiration does not set out to be comprehensive; Ivor Smith chooses examples that he finds particularly inspiring from the work of a few selected architects. The book will appeal to those both interested in and studying architecture.

Il controllo delle fasi di vita di un edificio (progetto, costruzione, manutenzione, riutilizzo) comporta la necessità di comunicazione e di cooperazione tra i diversi attori coinvolti nel processo. L'uso passivo delle risorse, le capacità di far fronte alle necessità strutturali della costruzione, alle esigenze e alla disponibilità economica della committenza sono fattori determinanti, come dimostrato dagli esempi di best practice presenti sugli scenari internazionali analizzati in questo volume. Al fine di definire strategie virtuose e potenzialmente applicabili all'edilizia residenziale italiana sono state isolate quattro tecniche di intervento desunte dai casi studio: aggiornare, ampliare, aggiungere, ri-modellare. La scelta dei riferimenti, utili a formare una sorta di scatola degli attrezzi per le opere di riqualificazione integrata è stata operata in funzione della comparabilità con manufatti analoghi, per consistenza e patologie, presenti anche nel patrimonio residenziale italiano. Nel volume sono inoltre raccolti progetti, ai quali ha partecipato l'autrice, ritenuti utili per il loro carattere sperimentale, a verificare sul campo gli assunti teorici emersi dalla ricerca.
