Access Registry Editor by following this procedure: In Windows 10 or Windows 8.1, right-click or tap-and-hold the Start button and then choose Run. Prior to Windows 8.1, the Run dialog box is most easily available from the Apps screen. In Windows 7 or Windows Vista, select Start.

The Windows Registry and the Microsoft Registry Editor program are available in nearly every Microsoft Windows version including Windows 10, Windows 8, Windows 7, Windows Vista, Windows XP, Windows 2000, Windows NT, Windows 98, and Windows 95.

Windows Registry (What It Is and How to Use It)

The Windows 8 registry has the same structure as its predecessors. The principles of storing operating system settings haven't changed, and the tool to edit the registry is the old faithful regedit. The only difference is there are more keys providing more configuration options.

Windows 8 Registry Editor Regedit - Computer Performance

Windows 8 Type regedit on the Start screen and select the regedit option in the search results. If prompted by User Account Control, click Yes to open the Registry Editor. The Windows Registry Editor window should open and look similar to the example shown below.

How do I open and edit the Windows registry?

.Reg is THE file extension associated with the Windows 8 registry editor. The purpose of such files is to merge, or tattoo settings into the registry. What makes the whole process transparent is that.reg files are text based, thus you can open them with Notepad and make changes. Using Windows 8.Reg Files

Note. The registry in 64-bit versions of Windows XP, Windows Server 2003, and Windows Vista is divided into 32-bit and 64-bit keys. Many of the 32-bit keys have the same names as their 64-bit counterparts, and vice versa.

There are two ways to open Registry Editor in Windows 10: In the search box on the taskbar, type regedit.Then, select the top result for Registry Editor (Desktop app). Press and hold or right-click the Start button, then select Run.. Enter regedit in the Open: box and select OK.

How to open Registry Editor in Windows 10
